ANATOMY OF A FALL

In the award-winning mystery thriller *Anatomy of a Fall* we meet Sandra, her husband Samuel, and their eleven-year-old son Daniel who for the past year have lived a secluded life in a remote town in the French Alps. When Samuel is found dead in the snow below their chalet, the police question whether he was murdered or committed suicide. Samuel's suspicious death is presumed murder, and Sandra becomes the main suspect. What follows is an unsettling psychological journey into the depths of Sandra and Samuel's conflicted relationship. This year's opening hit at the NZ International Film Festival and winner of the Cannes Film Festival Palme d'Or. Scored 7.9/10 on IMDb and 98% on Rotten Tomatoes.

LOOP TRACK

Directed by and also starring Tom Sainsbury, **the New Zealand made** psychological thriller **Loop Track** follows the highly anxious Ian Thompson (*Tom Sainsbury*) who just wants to be left alone and get as far away from humanity as possible to relax and clear his head. He embarks on a solitary four-day tramp through the remote New Zealand bush, but to his utter dismay he meets other trampers who attach themselves to him. As their idle chatter disturbs his solitude, Ian can't stop feeling they are all being watched and followed. Is it just in his head? Or is there someone out there... or *something!!*

Now, far from civilisation, with Ian's paranoia growing and his grasp on reality diminishing rapidly, the four-day tramp slowly transforms into a tense & desperate fight for survival with an explosive finale.

Scored 8.5/10 on IMDb.

KILLERS OF THE FLOWER MOON

At the turn of the 20th century, oil brought a fortune to the North American Osage Nation who became some of the richest people in the world overnight. The wealth of these native Americans immediately attracted white interlopers who manipulated, and stole as much Osage money as they could before resorting to murder. Based on a true story and told through the romance of Ernest Burkhart (Leonardo DiCaprio) and Mollie Kyle (Laly Gladstone), *Killers of the Flower Moon* also stars Robert De Niro and Jesse Plemons. Directed by Academy Award winner Martin Scorsese it is based on David Grann's best-selling book. Scored 10/10 on IMDb and 97% on Rotten Tomatoes.

Based on the true story of Napoléon Bonaparte, Oscar and BAFTA winner Joaquin Phoenix stars as the French military commander and political leader who rose to prominence during the French Revolution. The film primarily depicts the leader's swift and ruthless rise to power as well as his addictive and often volatile relationship with his wife, the Empress Joséphine.

THE OLD OAK is the story of a village in the Northeast of England, where the mine closed, and people feel deserted by the system. Many young ones have left and what was once a thriving, proud community struggles to keep old values alive. But there is growing anger, resentment, and a lack of hope. Houses are cheap and available.
